# **Activity Name and Brief Description:**

Warm up plus emotion walk with scenarios including hot button topics, teacher also demonstrates, a few students volunteer to show theirs and take the lead (day two: similar activity incorporating props that will be used for the dances, read graffiti walls from previous day to use for scenarios)

### Main Exercise

**Objective:** To express emotion through music and dance

### **Activity Name and Brief Description:**

Playing excerpts from Peter and the Wolf, students volunteer to show theirs and to talk about the emotions they experienced, this then evolves into a class dance

(day two: students will do a short free-write to come up with story ideas, then students break into groups and create dances with the props and their story ideas, then they will each perform)

### Reflection (woven throughout but important to share and notice creative choices)

**Objective:** To notice how emotions can be expressed through music and dance

#### **Brief Description:**

Graffit walls with emojis and open questions, observations about emotion walk, Peter and the wolf, Group dance share

# **Closing Ritual**

Objective: To provide closure and inner strength

After reflection, will do the emotion walk again and turn it into red light, green light, 123 game lastly will do TATIP's I have a voice, but using different emotions
